

## **ECREA CEE NETWORK report for 2020**

The pandemic situation caused severe complications on the side of the selected organizer of the 2021 CEECOM conference, the Masaryk University in Brno, Czech Republic, which resulted in intense negotiations between the CEE Network's team and the Masaryk University representatives. They, in the end, asked the CEE board to postpone the CEECOM conference plans to 2022. In reaction to this situation and given the long period of time between the last CEECOM conference (2019) and the one to be held in 2023 – since the CEECOM became a bi-annual conference –, the board has decided to look for other possible organisers who would be able to go for an online conference already in 2021. Luckily, the Institute of Journalism, Media & Social Communication at the Jagiellonian University (Cracow, Poland) along with the Polish Communication Association decided to step in as hosts of CEECOM 2021. The dates of the conference are October 22–23, 2021 and it is going to be an online conference (<https://idmiksuj.edu.pl/ceecom2021>).
