

ACTIVITY REPORT FILM STUDIES SECTION ECREA 2013

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1. Planning and organizing the 2013 ECREA film studies section interim conference

- ✓ The two-day conference “European Film Cultures” was held at the Centre for Languages and Literature, at Lund University, Sweden, on 8-9 November 2013. Prof. Paul McDonald (University of Nottingham) and Prof. Daniel Biltereyst (Ghent University) presented keynote lectures on central topics of the conference: “Formulating an Agenda for Film Industries Research” and “Multiple Audiences: Revisiting Historical Film Reception” respectively.
- ✓ The conference furthermore welcomed around 70 participants, most of whom presented papers in one of the 15 panels. The researchers represented 15 different nations across Europe (and the US), confirming the relevance of a pan-European research network. There was a good variation of topics presented, with some research areas gathering somewhat more papers; for example various aspects of film industries, audience/reception, film festivals and minor cinemas. There were rewarding discussions, both during the sessions and during the breaks.
- ✓ Business meeting section minutes: A meeting open to all conference attendants was held at the end of the conference, where past and future actions and events were discussed.
- ✓ The publisher Intellect was present during the conference.
